

### Appendix A.3 GREAT SupremeHealth A / B (Non As-Charged Plans)

- (a) Hospitalisation expenses will now include expenses under eligible **Mobile Inpatient Care at Home (“MIC@Home”)** stays, where all criteria for a claim under MSHL are met.
- (b) **Outpatient Cancer Drug Treatment (“CDT”) on the Cancer Drug List (“CDL”)** will be enhanced to cover up to the sum of the highest CDT limit<sup>[1]</sup> among the claimable treatments received for each primary cancer per month<sup>[2]</sup>, if the Life Assured is receiving treatment for Multiple Primary Cancers<sup>[3]</sup>.
- (c) **Outpatient Cancer Drug Services (“CDS”)** will be enhanced to cover up to 5x of MediShield Life’s (“MSHL”) limit for Multiple Primary Cancers per period of insurance<sup>[4]</sup> if the Life Assured is receiving treatment for Multiple Primary Cancers<sup>[3]</sup>.
- (d) **Coverage of Pregnancy and Childbirth Complications** will be enhanced to cover cervical incompetency, gestational diabetes mellitus, medically necessary abortion, postpartum haemorrhage and placental insufficiency & intrauterine growth restriction. Breech delivery will be removed from the list of complications covered. Delivery procedure for childbirth including caesarean delivery will not be covered, except in the event of an emergency caesarean section arising from one of the specified pregnancy or childbirth complications.
- (e) **Expenses for Psychiatric Treatment** will now be covered up to \$4,000 / \$3,000 (for GSH A/ GSH B respectively) per period of insurance. Coverage for pre-hospitalisation psychiatric treatment expenses will be removed.
- (f) **Daily Ward and Treatment Charges** will now cover Pre-Hospitalisation Treatment up to 180 days before hospitalisation.
- (g) **Daily Ward and Treatment Charges** will now cover Post-Hospitalisation Treatment up to 365 days from hospital discharge. Post-Hospitalisation Treatment will be enhanced to cover speech therapy, occupational therapy and physical therapy.
- (h) Expenses incurred for consultations, treatments and tests in connection with and prior to **outpatient kidney dialysis treatment, proton beam therapy, cell, tissue and gene therapy, radiotherapy for cancer and cancer drug treatment** will now be covered up to 120 days before such outpatient treatment.
- (i) **Expenses for Proton Beam Therapy (“PBT”)** will now be enhanced to cover up to \$40,000/ \$20,000 (for GSH A/ GSH B respectively) per period of insurance. However, such expenses will only be covered if PBT is administered for the Ministry of Health of Singapore (“MOH”)-approved indication and if the eligibility criteria for PBT under MSHL is met<sup>[7]</sup>.
- (j) The increase in **Deductibles** will now be applicable for policyholders following the age of 80 years next birthday on the renewal date.
- (k) **Pro-ration factors** of GSH B will be revised as follows:
